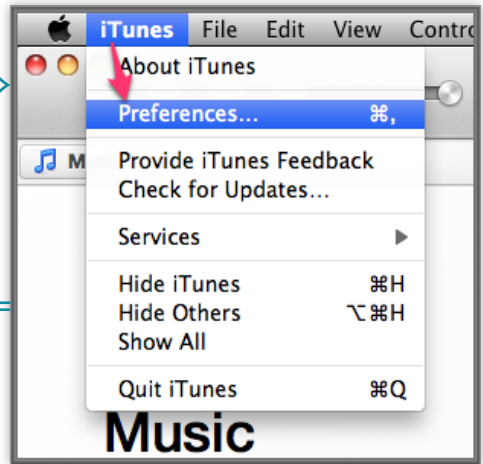


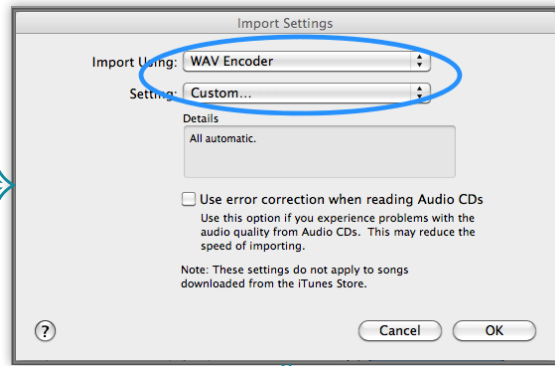
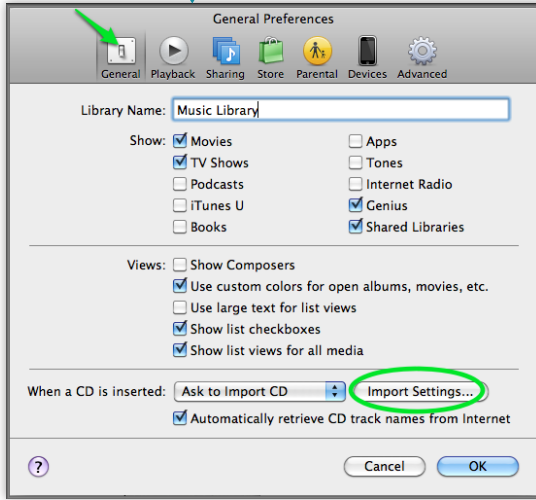


CONVERTING TRACKS IN ITUNES

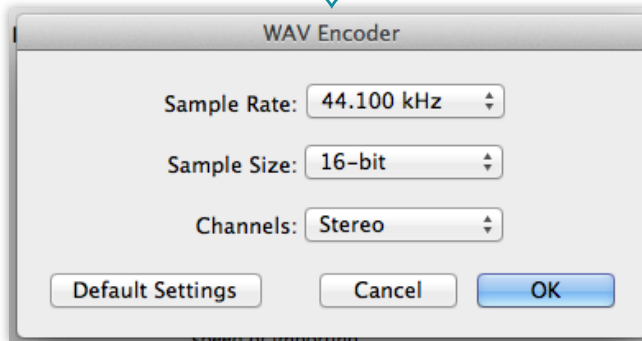
1 Open iTunes, and go to preferences



2 Make sure that you are on the General tab. Go to import settings. (in older versions of iTunes, you may have to go to advanced then import settings.) Change the "Import Using" to WAV Encoder and "Setting" to Custom. Once you have done this, a new window will open.



3 Once you are in the Custom window, change your sample rate to 44.100 kHz and your sample size to 16-bit. Channels needs to be set to Stereo. Click OK until you are back to your iTunes library.



4 Now your preferences are set. You will not have to do steps 1-3 again. To convert your tracks, follow these steps.

FROM YOUR MUSIC LIBRARY:

1. Select the track(s) you want to convert
2. Go to File>Create New Version
3. Select Wav file
4. The file will be created and added to your music library
